Dear Mr. Matthews:


This is an update to my March 13, 2006 letter advising you of Amarillo Power, LLC ("Amarillo Power")'s intention to prepare and submit to the NRC an application for an Early Site Permit ("ESP") for a reactor site in the vicinity of Amarillo, Texas. Since that letter, Amarillo Power has changed its choice of reactor technology and now intends to construct and operate two U.S. Evolutionary Power Reactors at the site. Because of the change in technology, our intention to work with UniStar, and other commercial factors, it is now our plan to forego an ESP and go directly to a Combined Construction Permit and Operating License Application and submit same in the last calendar quarter of 2008. We will contact you in April to schedule a meeting to provide an updated schedule and more detailed information.
